Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 μ l of sterile 1 \times PBS (PH=7.4).

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

Predicted Reactivity: Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used


for immunization is 100% homologues with the sequence in *Brassica* napus, and 80-99% homologues with the sequence in *Arabidopsis* thaliana, Solanum tuberosum, Solanum lycopersicum, Nicotiana tabacum, Populus trichocarpa, Vitis vinifera, Triticum aestivum, Panicum virgatum, Glycine max, Oryza sativa, Hordeum vulgare,



Sorghum bicolor, Setaria viridis, Gossypium raimondii, Medicago truncatula, Cucumis sativus, Zea mays.

Application Example



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 43 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
