Background:	AGO5 is a specialized Argonaute protein in Arabidopsis that binds small
	interfering RNAs (siRNAs) to direct RNA silencing. It primarily targets viral RNAs
	and transposable elements, providing antiviral defense and maintaining
	genome integrity. AGO5 also regulates reproductive development, with mutants
	showing reduced fertility due to defective gametogenesis.

Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 μ l of sterile 1XPBS (PH=7.4) containing 30% glycerol.

Stability &	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage:	12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.
	6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
	1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the
	temperature recommended above.



Application Example



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 43 kDa.
Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE
Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.
Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.
Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.
Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.



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
