Background: GRF7 is a growth-regulating transcription factor in maize. It promotes cell

proliferation and expansion, influencing leaf growth and organ size, and is post-

transcriptionally regulated.

Zea mays GRF7 (Zm00001d035965, Zm00001eb269150).

Form: Lyophilized

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

**Stability &**Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

**Storage:** 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

**Shipping:** The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

end user.



## **Application Example**



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the

peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 43 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

**Transfer:** blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

**Detection:** using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
