Background: MAP65-3 / PLE is a microtubule-associated protein. It bundles and stabilizes

microtubules, playing a crucial role in spindle formation during mitosis and in the organization of the phragmoplast during cytokinesis, essential for cell division

and expansion.

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

Recommended Dilution: Western Blot (1:1000-1:2000)




Predicted Reactivity:

Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used for immunization is 82% homologues with the sequence in *Brassica* napus, *Brassica* rapa.

Application Example



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 45 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
