**Description:** Rabbit polyclonal antibody

Background: AGO9 belongs to the Argonaute (AGO) proteins. AGO9-dependent sRNA

silencing is crucial to specify cell fate in the Arabidopsis ovule. It is expressed in reproductive companion cells but not in the associated male or female gametes or their precursors. Therefore, AGO9 acts non-cell autonomously to silencing

the activity of TEs activity in the female gametophyte.

**Synonyms:** AGO9, ARGONAUTE 9

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (14 aa from N terminal section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana AGO9 (AT5G21150).

Form: Lyophilized

**Quantity**: 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen affinity purified

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitution with 150 µl of 0.01 M sterile PBS.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

**Stability &**Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

**Storage:** 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

**Shipping:** The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

end user.



## **Application Example**



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 53 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

**Transfer:** blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

**Detection:** using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
