Background: OsAOX1A is a mitochondrial alternative oxidase in rice. It regulates the

alternative respiratory pathway, dissipates excess electrons, and confers tolerance to abiotic stresses such as cold and drought by reducing reactive

oxygen species production.

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (17 aa from central section) derived from

Oryza sativa AOX1 (Os04g0600200).

Form: Lyophilized

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

Predicted Reactivity: Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used


for immunization is 100% homologues with the sequence in Triticum



aestivum, Hordeum vulgare, and 80-99% homologues with the sequence in Setaria viridis, Sorghum bicolor, Panicum virgatum.

Application Example



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide

for immunization and having a molecular mass of 44 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4° C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4 °C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
