Description:	Rabbit polyclonal antibody
Background:	HSP101 belongs to the casein lytic proteinase/heat shock protein 100 (Clp/Hsp100) family. It is involved in refolding of proteins which form aggregates under heat stress. AtHsp101 is a cytosolic heat shock protein required for acclimation to high temperature.
Synonyms:	HSP101, ATHSP101, HEATSHOCK PROTEIN 101, HOT1
Immunogen:	KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (16 aa from C terminal section) derived from Arabidopsis thaliana HSP101 (AT1G74310).
Form:	Lyophilized
Quantity:	150 µg
Purification:	Immunogen affinity purified
Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile 1XPBS (PH=7.4) containing 30% glycerol. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
Stability & Storage:	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.
