Description:	Rabbit polyclonal antibody
Background:	PetG is cytochrome b6-f complex subunit V which is the component of the cytochrome b6-f complex, which mediates electron transfer between photosystem II (PSII) and photosystem I (PSI), cyclic electron flow around PSI, and state transitions. It is required for either the stability or assembly of the cytochrome b6-f complex.

Immunogen:	KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (15 aa from C terminal section) derived from <i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i> PetG (ATCG00600).
Form:	Lyophilized
Quantity:	150 µg
Purification:	Immunogen affinity purified
Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile 1XPBS (PH=7.4) containing 30% glycerol. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
Stability & Storage:	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.

Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used for immunization is 100% homologues with the sequence in *Brassica napus*, *Nicotiana tabacum*, and 80-99% homologues with the sequence in *Cucumis sativus*, *Triticum aestivum*, *Physcomitrium patens*, *Gossypium raimondii*, *Oryza sativa*, *Spinacia oleracea*, *Brassica rapa*, *Panicum virgatum*, *Glycine max*, *Solanum tuberosum*.
