Description:	Rabbit polyclonal antibody
Background:	AT1G10960 encodes Ferredoxin 1 (FD1), a chloroplastic 2Fe-2S iron-sulfur protein. It functions as an electron carrier in the photosynthetic electron transport chain and is involved in response to karrikin.
Synonyms:	FD1, AtFd1, ATFD1, Ferredoxin-1.
Immunogen:	Recombinant protein (50-148 aa) derived from <i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i> FD1 (AT1G10960).
Form:	Lyophilized
Quantity:	150 µg
Purification:	Protein A purified
Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile 1XPBS (PH=7.4) containing 30% glycerol. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
Stability & Storage:	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.

Recommended Dilution:	Western Blot (1:1000-1:2000) Note: Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.
Expected / apparent MW:	16 kDa
Confirmed Reactivity:	Coming soon
Predicted Reactivity:	Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used for immunization is 80-99% homologues with the sequence in <i>Brassica napus</i> .
