Description: Mouse monoclonal antibody

Immunogen: Recombinant protein corresponding to fragment (aa 21-245) RFP Tag.

Form: Lyophilized

Purification: Protein A purified

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of 0.01 M sterile PBS.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70° C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

Recommended Dilution: Western Blot (1:1000-1:2000)



Confirmed Reactivity: Anti-RFP tag recognizes recombinant protein RFP and RFP-tagged

fusion proteins.



Application Example



Recom: 10 ng, 25 ng and 40 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 34 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4° C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4° C.

Secondary antibody: 1:5000 dilution using Goat Anti-Mouse IgG H&L

(HRP) (Cat# PHY6006).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured

with CCD camera.
