Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70° C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4 °C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.
