Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70° C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.



Application Example



Cr-TP: 10 µg total protein from WT of Chlamydomonas reinhardtii.

Electrophoresis: 15% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L(HRP)

(Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with

CCD camera.
