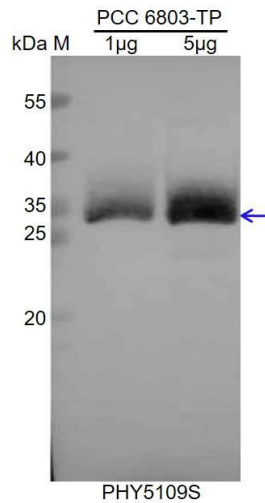
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| Description: | Rabbit polyclonal antibody |
| Background: | Phycobilisome rod linker polypeptide, encoded by the <i>CpcC1</i> gene (<i>sll1580</i>) in <i>Synechocystis</i> sp. PCC 6803. |
| Synonyms: | CpcC1 |
| Immunogen: | Recombinant protein of CpcC1 (2-291aa) derived from <i>Synechocystis</i> sp. PCC 6803 (<i>sll1580</i>). |
| Form: | Lyophilized |

| Purification: | Serum |
| Reconstitution: | Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube". |
| Stability & Storage: | Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. |
| Shipping: | The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above. |

Application Example



PCC 6803-TP is total protein from *Synechocystis sp.* PCC 6803 cells containing 1 µg and 5 µg of protein, respectively.

Electrophoresis: 15% SDS-Urea-PAGE.

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT for 1h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.
