Background: PIF5 is a novel Myc-related bHLH transcription factor, which physically

associated with APRR1/TOC1 and is a member of PIF3 transcription factor

family. It is involved in shade avoidance.

PHYTOCHROME-INTERACTING FACTOR 5, PIL6

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (17 aa from Central section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana PIF5 (AT3G59060).

Form: Lyophilized

Quantity: 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen affinity purified

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of 0.01 M sterile PBS.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70° C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.
