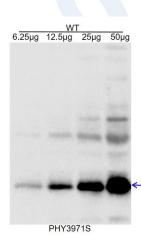

Application Example



WT: thylakoid membrane protein from *Arabidopsis thaliana* containing 6.25 μg, 12.5 μg, 25 μg and 50 μg of chlorophyll, respectively. **Electrophoresis:** 15% SDS-PAGE.

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4℃ for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.



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
