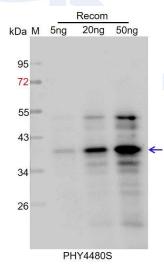

Application Example



Recom: 5 ng, 20 ng and 50 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 40 kDa. **Electrophoresis:** 12% SDS-PAGE **Transfer:** blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h. **Blocking:** 5% skim milk at RT or 4° C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.
